PICKING UP AND DROPPING OFF PEOPLE – KISS-AND-RIDE AREAS

Both parking East (Oost) and parking West have a kiss-and-ride area.

You can (briefly) leave your care behind to accompany a patient to the hospital or to pick him up. Long-term parking (more than 30 minutes) is not allowed.

There are wheelchairs in the parking and at the entrance.

For patients with walking difficulties there is a kiss-and-ride area at the reception hall of entrance East (Dost). You can stop here for five minutes.

EMERGENCY ROOM

Follow the arrows to the emergency room ('Spoed') and enter the parking to the ambulance hall of the emergency room. The gate will open as soon as you arrive.

Drop off the patient at one of the designated parking spaces at the entrance of the emergency room.

Once you have done this, please park your car as quickly as possible in the emergency room parking. The parking ticket you received upon entering will automatically give you access to the care rate (activation is not necessary). If you leave within 30 minutes, you do not have to pay.

Do you have an appointment at the surgical outpatient clinic, the oncological outpatient clinic or the kidney centre?

These departments have separate parking arrangements. You can get more information at the departments involved or talk to the front desk staff at entrance East (Oost) and entrance West.



PARKING EAST (OOST) AND PARKING WEST

There are two parkings in UZ Leuven: parking East (Oost) and parking West.

Parking East (Oost) is located nearest the Leuven ring, at Het Teken roundabout and used to be referred to as 'Bezoekersparking'. On the Gasthuisberg campus ring road, follow the arrows to **POost**.

Parking West is located nearest the E314, at the Vogelzang roundabout, near the fire brigade (see map). On the Gasthuisberg campus ring road, follow the arrows to **P** West.



CARE RATE FOR PATIENTS

As a patient you are entitled to the care rate. This is never more than 6 euro a day, on the condition that your car does not leave the parking in

Activating the care rate is possible at any point in time, between registration and leaving the parking.

registration booth, via the munexuzhealth app or with the front desk staff at the registration desk.

WEEKLY SUBSCRIPTION = 15 EURO

Will you be admitted for more than three days? You or your next of kin will be entitled to the weekly subscription.

Arrange the week subscription when you enrol at the registration booth, the mynexuzhealth app or with front desk staff at the registration desk. You'll need the patient's electronic ID-card and the parking ticket.

Before you leave the parking for the first time with the week subscription, you'll pay 15 euro at the ticket machine. At the barrier. the ticket reader will return you your parking ticket. Use it the next time to enter and exit the parking. The subscription is valid up until day 7 after first entrance.

FREE SUBSCRIPTION FOR CHRONIC PATIENTS AND LONG-TERM TREATMENTS

In specific cases it is possible to park for free, i.e. when you have to come to the hospital frequently because of a chronic disorder or because you are undergoing long-term treatment.

- Ask your attending physician if you qualify for a free subscription.
- If you meet the criteria, you will receive a 'chronic patient' certificate.
- Take the certificate to the cash register in the reception hall of entrance East (Oost) (past the shop, on your right-hand side)
- There you will receive your free subscription.

Opening hours cash register: on weekdays from 9 to 12.30 hrs and from 13.30 to 16 hrs.
